Rope Halter Instructions

HALTER KNOT

1. Bring crown piece behind ears and slide through loop at top of cheek piece, with tip angled toward horse's tail. See fit & adjustment.
2. Bring tail forward, under halter, at the base of the loop, above the eye knot.
3. Tie off by bringing tip of crown piece back toward horse's tail, tying below the loop and above the eye knot. Make sure the tail of the crown piece is pointed toward the horse's tail and there are no twists in the rope. Make sure the knot is snug.

HALTER FIT & ADJUSTMENT

Put horse's nose through nose band, bring crown piece strap behind ears, pull up on halter until the throat knot is all the way to the horse's throat, then tie off. The cheek knots should be just below the bottom of the cheek bones. The halter should not be tight but should not be so loose under the chin that a foot could get caught.

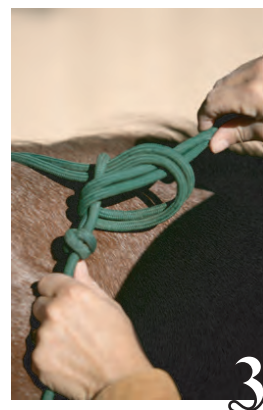
STANDARD LEAD ATTACHMENT

1. Bring tassel end of lead through the bottom loop of halter, below fiador knot. Pull through about 12" of rope.
2. Put your left hand on lead, just on left side of halter loop, reach behind halter with right hand and grab tassel and pull it toward the horse's tail.
3. Put the tassel end through the loop created by your left hand, so that the knot is tied around the loop, just below the fiador knot. The knot should be tied on the loop, not below it.

PREMIUM LEAD ATTACHMENT

1. Slide spliced loop end over the halter's bottom loop.
2. Bring tail of lead (the end with the lash) through halter's bottom loops.
3. Pull lead rope all the way through, taking out any twists in rope and snug knot, forming a knot that looks like a figure eight.
