

Normal hoof pastern axis




Low hoof pastern axis, steep pastern, low hoof capsule




Improved alignment after trim. (before trim on left, after trim on right.)

Alignment of mass through pastern bones




Heel first landing

Dr. Page's Suggestions to Horse Owners

- Get lateral radiographs of your horse's feet once a year
- Take a slo-motion video, from the side, of your horse walking on a hard, flat surface, to see if the horse is landing heel first
- Check the symmetry of your horse's feet
